**RSOs** *The medical school’s student organizations with a role in community service include:*

- *the school’s chapters of the American Medical Association – Medical Student Section, American Medical Student Association*
- *Student National Medical Association*
- *American Medical Women’s Association.*
- *Interdisciplinary Network for Outreach (INFO) as a basis for student-led, health-related outreach projects. Examples of the medical students’ community service projects included*
  - *assisting at local food drives,*
  - *a 5K run for a local charity,*
  - *the medical school’s free clinic for the homeless and uninsured, and*

- *various Enos School projects (such as health education and reading programs).*
  - *Student National Medical Association chapter and its Office of Diversity, Multicultural and Minority Affairs - develop and conduct a health education, healthy living, and screening program for members of Springfield's African-American community; this program is delivered in local churches with large minority populations.*

*A large percentage of the student special interest groups have incorporated community service into their missions and are instrumental in outreach to the community. The Family Medicine Interest Group was recently awarded a Program of Excellence award recognizing them for various aspects including their commitment to community engagement.*

### **Non-medical Volunteering**

*In addition to the medical school's community service opportunities, SIU's medical students **serve their communities on their own time** as individuals in a variety of ways. In AY2013, medical students –*

- *volunteered at local women's shelters, breadlines, youth groups/programs, nursing homes, cancer support groups, animal shelters, and church groups.*
- *They were scout troop leaders, camp counselors, big brothers/big sisters, youth league sports coaches, and mentors to disadvantaged children.*
- *They participated in mission trips, both medical and non-medical ones. In these ways, the medical students advanced the medical school's mission through their individual commitment to serve their community.*
